A DAY IN THE LIFE...

A typical camp day during the week:

EARLY ARRIVAL

Fee: \$7/day/child

Early arrival arrangements and payment must be included with the registration form for scheduling purposes. Campers will be supervised but in a less structured environment. The early arrival fee must be applied for any camper dropped off between 7:30am and 8:20am.

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

Pre-K Half Day Camp (Week 1) 8:30am-1:00pm

Club Members: \$150/child/week

Non-Members: \$175/child/week

Ages 6-11 Camp 8:30am-5:30pm

Club Members: \$250/child/week

Non-Members: \$300/child/week

Membership must be current at the time of registration to receive member rates.

Register your child(ren) by returning a completed registration form and a \$100 deposit/child/session. Please note that a separate form must be completed for each child. Children will only be enrolled with the submission of a completed registration form. After your camp registration and deposit are received, you will be notified of your enrollment status via e-mail. The full remaining balance must be paid by May 1, 2011.

If registration occurs after May 1st, payment must be made in FULL upon submission of registration.

RECEIVE A \$ 50 DISCOUNT OFF EACH CHILD'S TOTAL IF YOU SIGN UP FOR 4 OR MORE WEEKS OF CAMP!

CANCELLATION POLICY/LATE FEES

Refunds may be awarded if cancellations are made in writing three weeks prior to the first day of the camp session to be cancelled, less a cancellation fee of \$25/child/session. Partial attendance will not be reimbursed or credited. In case of insufficient registrations, the Club reserves the right to cancel a session two weeks prior to the start of the session. In this instance, participants will receive a full refund. The Club also reserves the right to ask a camper not to return to camp due to behavioral issues. If a camper is asked to leave, all fees will be forfeited. More information on our Behavior Code can be found in the information packet.

LATE FEE: A \$15 late fee will be charged for every 15 minutes beyond 5:30pm when regular hours of camp end that a child is waiting for pick-up if notice has not been given.
