### ALCOHOL POLICY

Our Club is a licensed premise by the Alcohol Beverage Commission. This means that any alcohol consumed on the premises (including pool/deck areas) **must be purchased from the Club snack bar.** Management thanks you in advance for abiding by ABC laws. Please note that if any outside alcohol is brought onto the property it will have to be removed from the premise. If you are interested in having alcohol at your gazebo party, contact Drew in the office to place an order!

### RUBBER PANTS POLICY

All children not potty-trained are required to wear a swim diaper with rubber pants over them. Rubber pants can be purchased from the Check-In desk for \$2.00 per pair. Please note, the swim diaper AND rubber pants are required in order to be able to swim in larger pool or the baby pool. Hopefully, this will keep accidents from happening in the pool forcing closure. We thank you for your cooperation in advance.

### MEMBERSHIP CARD POLICY

As you enter the facility, you are required to have appropriate membership cards. Each person on your membership was presented a tag upon joining the Club. You are required to have the membership card with you or your belongings at all times. Members are not allowed to simply give their name and membership number without presentation of a the membership card. Replacement cards are \$2 and can be requested at the Check In desk.

### FAQ:

Do you have different rates on 4th of July for guests?

Yes. On holidays, you're welcome to bring guests or family members. However, the July 4th guest fee rates are:

*Regular Guest*

\$15.00 with food or \$8.00 without.

*Child Regular Guest (6 & Under):*

\$10.00 with food or \$6.00 without.

*Relative or Punch Pass*

\$8.00 with food or \$4.00 without.
