STAY AWAY FROM SUMMER SNATCHERS!

Although we maintain a fun and safe environment here at the Woodcroft Club, we have had some theft incidents in our parking lot this summer. - Install an antitheft device if you don't already have one.

- Remove any portable electronic devices (GPS, XM radio)

POLICY REMINDERS RUBBER PANTS

All children not potty-trained are required to wear a swim diaper with rubber pants over them. Rubber pants can be purchased from the Check-In desk for \$2.00 per pair. Please note, the swim diaper AND rubber pants are required in order to be able to swim in the larger pool or the baby pool. Hopefully, this will keep accidents from happening in the pool forcing closure.

We thank you for your cooperation in advance.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS

As you enter the facility, you are required to have appropriate membership cards. Each person on your membership was presented a tag upon joining the Club. You are required to have the membership card with you or your belongings at all times. Members are not allowed to simply give their name and membership number without presentation of a membership card. Replacement cards are \$2 and can be requested at the Check In desk.

ALCOHOL

Our Club is a licensed premise by the Alcohol Beverage Commission. This means that any alcohol consumed on the premises (including pool/deck areas) **must be purchased from the Club snack bar.**

Management thanks you in advance for abiding by ABC laws. Please note that if any outside alcohol is brought onto the property it will have to be removed from the premise. If you are interested in having alcohol at your gazebo party, contact us in the office to place an order!

Beat the Heat!

It's "summertime, and the livin' is easy." For kids & adults, life during summer can be downright sweltering. Many activities such as ball games, tennis clinics, band camp, and football training take place during this hot season. Everyone is at risk for dehydration and heat illness when exposed to sun, high temperatures, and humidity.

However, children are at a greater risk because a child's body surface makes up a much greater proportion of his overall weight compared to an adult. Know the signs of dehydration. The thirst mechanism does not kick-in until a child has already lost about 2% of her body weight through sweat. Make sure your child drinks plenty of cool, plain water or sports drinks to stay completely hydrated. Regular breaks to drink fluids should be scheduled, even if your child is not thirsty. Regular fruit juice and soft drinks do NOT re-hydrate the body because they don't contain the right amounts of sugar and electrolytes. **Enjoy the pool, but stay cool!**
