Want to be a part of the legendary Woodcroft Whirlwinds? To participate, children must be able to swim the length of the pool independently by the end of the second week of practice. The swimmer's age as of June 1, 2011 will determine the correct age group for the season. All swimmers will be evaluated in the first two weeks of practice to determine their swim level based on American Red Cross standards. This two weeks is a trial period for you and your child to determine if swim team is right for you. If you decide, after the two weeks, that swim team is not a perfect fit, you'll receive a partial refund minus a \$25 Processing Fee (For New Swimmers Only).
